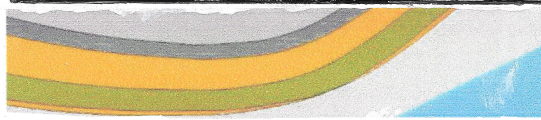

PRESIDENT

In 1971, Representative Stathos of Jacksonville introduced the Oregon Bicycle Bill into the state legislature. The bill, adopted as ORS 366.514, provides that a minimum of one percent of highway construction funds be spent to build bike paths on newly built and reconstructed roads. At the time this concept of committing public money to bike lanes was revolutionary.
